VENUE INFORMATION

Due to a clash of dates, we are not able to return to the Central Hall Westminster this year. The capacity of the YCBC is limited, so whilst we expect to be able to accommodate demand on Sunday, we may have to close the entry to the Pairs on Saturday. Players are advised to enter as soon as possible for both days, as entries for both will be accepted on a strictly first-come first-served basis.

Address: Young Chelsea Bridge Club, 54 Goldhawk Road, London, W12 8HA

Getting there: The venue is directly opposite Goldhawk Road tube station on the north side of Goldhawk Road. Entry is through the black gate to the right of Sainsbury's and across the yard behind.

By Public transport: Hammersmith & City Line or Circle Line to Goldhawk Road Station. Central Line or Overground to Shepherd's Bush Station - approx. 8 minutes walk. District or Piccadilly Line to Hammersmith Station – approx. 15 minutes walk.

Buses 94 and 237 go along Goldhawk Road and stop outside the premises – the 94 is a 24-hour service. Numerous other bus routes serve the Shepherd's Bush area – numbers: 31, 49, 72, 95, 148, 207, 220, 228, 260, 272, 283, 295, 316, 607, C1 and N207

By Car: Parking is freely available all day at weekends on many streets to the west and south of the venue, Some nearby roads, are restricted on Saturdays and Sundays, however, with residents-only parking at some times, so should be avoided. See <u>www.ycbc.co.uk</u> for more details and a map.

Please allow plenty of time to reach the venue by any method, because of traffic & road/rail works, always bad in central London at weekends.

Refreshments: A range of hot and cold food and drinks will be available all day each day, along with a licensed bar.

Accommodation is limited at the venue and entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is $\pounds 50.00$ per pair in the Swiss Pairs and $\pounds 100$ per team in the Swiss Teams. This equates to $\pounds 25$ per person per day, but anyone playing on both days is entitled to a discount and need pay $\pounds 48$ only for the whole weekend.

Note that due to the change of venue, entry fees have not been increased in line with other competition entry fees this year.

All competitors must be members of the English Bridge Union. Non-members may apply to join the LMBA and EBU by completing the form on the back of the brochure – please include an additional \pounds 34.00
